## What Is Algebra?

Since multiplication is implied in Algebra, we often don't need to actually write the times symbol 'x'. Re-write this algebraic equation without the times symbol.

To show that you can identify implied multiplication, re-write this algebraic equation using the times symbol wherever multiplication is implied.

$$3(bc) = 2d$$
$$3 \times (b \times c) = 2 \times d$$
